Thomson McDuffie Regional Airport Operations During the 2019 Masters® Golf Tournament

Dear Patron,

Welcome to the 83rd annual Masters® Golf Tournament. We are honored that you have selected Spirit Aviation to serve as your airport for the Tournament. We are committed to providing you with world-class customer service, meeting your needs, and exceeding your expectations. *We are always available to answer questions or provide assistance as you plan your visit.*

Location: "35 Minutes, Runway to Fairway!" The Thomson McDuffie Regional Airport is located 35 minutes from the Masters Tournament; located near Interstate I-20, exit #172.

Airfield: The KHQU airport has a 5500 ft runway served by an ILS approach and on-field AWOS. Emergency Medical Service and Fire Station is located on field.

Fueling & Aircraft Services: Ground Support Equipment (GPU/LAV/Oxygen/Lektro/) is available to handle aircraft up to 80,000#. Fuel serving is provided on a first come, first served, priority based on departure requirements.

Ramp Fees & Aircraft Parking/Reservations: Daily ramp fees are imposed by the FBO and are mandatory for all aircraft to offset significant ground handling resources and personnel brought in for the event. Advance Parking Reservations are encouraged for all aircraft. If you have a reservation, we can guarantee a parking space for you.



Our ramp is capable of supporting a large number of aircraft. Aircraft will be parked based on estimated date/time of departure. *Please contact Spirit Aviation at (706) 595-1300. or visit our website at www.spirit-aviation.com, to make reservations.*

Ramp (Parking) Area: Ramp (parking) areas are congested with aircraft, vehicles, and pedestrians. The ramps are non-movement areas and are not controlled by Air Traffic Control (ATC). Pilots operating in these areas do so at their own risk. When taxiing in a parking area, be alert for parked aircraft, taxiing aircraft, aircraft with engines running, vehicle, and pedestrian traffic. Taxiing during hours of darkness or limited visibility is more demanding and requires greater attention.

Towing Aircraft: Spirit Aviation (FBO) has ample room for aircraft parking; however, line personnel frequently need to move parked aircraft to make the most efficient use of ramp space or to move up an aircraft to prepare for departure. Pilots are requested to leave their aircraft configured to tow. When you check in at the FBO customer service counter, please let a Customer Service Representative (CSR) know if the aircraft is not configured to tow, or if you would like to be contacted before moving your aircraft, or if you have special concerns about towing the aircraft.



FBO Check-In: All pilots are required to check in at the FBO Terminal customer service counter on arrival to provide local contact information, service requirements, and estimated departure information to aid in providing timely service and managing the ramp space.

Ground Transportation: Rental Cars are available through Enterprise Car Rental and Hertz. They will be on site throughout the event. Advance reservations are highly recommended. Walk up rental cars will be available in limited supply. Limo service is available but requires prior coordination due the limited availability and high demand for this event. Taxi service is generally not available from the Thomson McDuffie Airport to Augusta. A courtesy vehicle is available for flight crews for short trips away from the airport.

Catering: Complementary coffee and ice are provided. Outside catering can be accommodated but may incur charges for handling/setup based on resources required (refrigeration/pre-heating/aircraft delivery).
